

Sklar Spots Wildcat Near Discovery Well In Conecuh County

Sklar Exploration Co., LLC, Shreveport, La., has staked location for a Smackover wildcat near a recent discovery in southern Alabama's Conecuh County.

The company will drill the No. 1 Craft-Soterra, LLC 27-6, SE NW Section 27-5N-13E.

Location is one and three-quarter miles north-northwest of Melrose and one and one-half miles southwest of a recent Smackover oil discovery. Drill-site is also one and three-quarter miles north-northwest of Little Cedar Creek Field.

Scheduled for a depth of 10,850 feet, contractor is not immediately available.

One and one-half miles northeast of the new location, Midroc Operating Co. completed the No. 23-3 Cedar Creek Land & Timber, NE NW Section 23-5N-13E.

Productive from pay in Smackover, the discovery flowed 468 barrels 43-gravity oil, 418,000 cubic feet of gas and two barrels water per day through a 12/64-inch choke with flowing tubing pressure 1400 pounds. Gas-oil ratio was 893 to one.

Completion was from perforations 10,242-270 feet in Smackover.

Total depth of the discovery is 10,600 feet and 5 1/2-inch casing was run to 10,579 feet for completion.
