

Sklar Schedules Two Smackover Tests Near Little Cedar Creek

Sklar Exploration Co., LLC, Shreveport, La., has scheduled two Smackover tests east of production at Little Cedar Creek Field in southern Alabama's Conecuh County.

Location was surveyed for No. 1 Craft-Ralls 4-5, SW NW Section 4-4N-13E. The well, scheduled for a depth of 11,600 feet, is located on a 160-acre unit which includes the northwest quarter of Section 4.

One mile west of this location, Sklar earlier completed No. 1 Craft-Cedar Creek Land & Timber, Inc. 5-5, SW NW Section 5-4N-13E.

Productive from perforations 10,969-970 feet in Smackover, the well pumped 95 barrels 40-gravity oil per day.

About 3000 feet southwest of the No. 1 Craft-Ralls 4-5, Sklar has perforated 11,044-076 feet and is waiting on potential at the No. 1 Craft-Ralls 5-10, NW SE Section 5-4N-13E. Hole was drilled to 11,200 feet and has 5 1/2-inch casing to bottom.

At south offset to the No. 1 Craft-Ralls 4-5, Sklar will drill No. 1 Craft-Ralls 4-12, NW SW Section 4-4N-13E. Proposed depth is 11,600 feet to evaluate Smackover. Location is on a 160-acre unit which includes the southwest quarter of Section 4.

Contractor for the latest two locations are not known.
