

# Northeast Extension Indicated For Little Cedar Creek Field

**Sklar Exploration Co., LLC, Shreveport, La., has logged good shows in Smackover and run casing at a well northeast of production at Little Cedar Creek Field in southern Alabama's Conecuh County.**

The No. 1 Craft-Ralls 5-8, SE NE Section 5-4N-13E, was drilled to 11,150 feet. Shows were revealed by cores and logs and string of 5 1/2-inch casing was run to total depth for completion.

Rapad Drilling Co., Jackson, Miss., handled contract.

This well is located two miles west and slightly south of Melrose and three-quarters of a mile east of the nearest completed producer.

At southwest offset to the current well, however, Sklar has already run casing and perforated the No. 1 Craft-Ralls 5-10, NW SE Section 5-

4N-13E. The well was drilled to 11,200 feet and 5 1/2-inch casing was run to bottom for completion.

Perforations were reported in Smackover at 11,044-076 feet and the well is presently waiting on potential.

Nearest completed producing well lies three-quarters of a mile to the west where Sklar drilled No. 1 Craft-Cedar Creek Land & Timber, Inc. 5-5, SW NW Section 5-4N-13E.

Productive from perforations 10,960-970 feet in Smackover, the well pumped 95 barrels 40-gravity oil per day.

Little Cedar Creek Field now extends approximately eight miles in an east-northeast direction from the discovery producer.
