

Sklar Runs Production Pipe At Conecuh County Wildcat

Sklar Exploration Co., LLC, Shreveport, La., has run production casing to test shows logged in Smackover at a wildcat north of production at Little Cedar Creek Field in southern Alabama's Conecuh County.

The No. 1 Craft-Ralls 33-7, SW NE Section 33-5N-13E, was drilled to 10,880 feet. Shows were encountered in Smackover and string of 5 1/2-inch casing was run to 10,880 feet for evaluation.

Location of the potential producer is one-half mile north of previous production at Little Cedar Creek Field.

Location is on a 160-acre unit which includes the northeast quarter of Section 33.

Rapad Drilling & Well Service, Inc., Jackson, Miss., handled contract for drilling.

One-half mile south-southwest of the current well, Sklar earlier drilled No. 1 Craft-Ralls 33-14, SE SW

Section 33-5N-13E.

A Smackover completion, the well flowed 395 barrels 40-gravity oil and 382,000 cubic feet of gas per day through a 17/64-inch choke with flowing tubing pressure 440 pounds.

Production is from pay in Smackover from perforations 10,928-956 feet.

Total depth is 11,100 feet and 5 1/2-inch casing was run to bottom for completion.
