

Sklar To Fracture Smackover Wildcat In Escambia County

Sklar Exploration Co., LLC, Shreveport, La., will fracture a zone in Smackover at a wildcat in the extreme northeastern corner of Escambia County in southern Alabama.

The No. 1 Logan 5-7, SW NE Section 5-3N-13E, was perforated in a 12-foot interval in Smackover at 11,820-832 feet. The zone had previously been acidized.

The wildcat was drilled to 12,225 feet and string of 5 1/2-inch casing was run to total depth for evaluation.

Site of the indicated discovery is three-quarters of a mile southwest of the community of Brooklyn and three and three-quarter miles south and slightly east of Smackover oil production at Little Cedar Creek Field in adjoining Conecuh County.

Location is on a 160-acre unit which includes the northeast quarter of Section 5.

Three and three-quarter miles north and slightly west of the current wildcat, Midroc Operating Co. completed No. 24-1 McCreary, NE NE Section 24-4N-12E, at Little Cedar Creek Field.

A Smackover producer, the well flowed 266 barrels 48-gravity oil and 143,000 cubic feet of gas per day through a 14/64-inch choke with flowing tubing pressure 350 pounds.

Completion was from pay in Smackover through perforations 11,580-610 feet. Total depth is 11,747 feet and 5 1/2-inch casing was run to bottom for completion.
