

Sklar Runs Casing To Test Wildcat In Conecuh County

Sklar Exploration Co., LLC, Shreveport, La., has run production casing for completion at a Smackover wildcat in the Melrose area of southern Alabama's Conecuh County.

The No. 1 Craft-Soterra LLC 27-6, SE NW Section 27-5N-13E, was drilled to 10,710 feet. Shows were logged in Smackover and string of 5 1/2 inch casing was run to ——— feet for completion.

Details of shows logged in the wildcat and geological data are not available.

Rapad Drilling & Well Service, Inc., Jackson, Miss., handled contract.

Site of the indicated discovery is one and three-quarter miles north-northwest of Melrose and one and one-half miles southwest of a recent Smackover discovery. Drill-site is also one and three-quarter miles north-northeast of Smackover oil production in Little Cedar Creek Field.

One and one-half miles northeast of the current test, Midroc Operating Co. completed No. 23-3 Cedar Creek Land & Timber, NE NW Section 23-5N-13E.

A Smackover completion, the discovery flowed 468 barrels 43-gravity oil and 418,000 cubic feet of gas per day through a 12/64-inch choke with flowing tubing pressure 1400 pounds. Gas-oil ratio was 893 to one. Two barrels of water were also

reported in the recovery.

Completion was from perforations 10,242-270 feet opposite pay in Smackover.

Drilled to a depth of 10,600 feet, string of 5 1/2-inch casing was run to 10,579 feet for completion.
