

Sklar Gauges East Extension To Little Cedar Creek Field

Sklar Exploration Co., LLC, Shreveport, La., has completed a one-half mile east extension to Little Cedar Creek Field in southern Alabama's Conecuh County.

Production was reported for the company's No. 1 Craft-Mack 8-2, NW NE Section 8-4N-13E. A Smackover completion, the well flowed 284 barrels 47-gravity oil and 197,000 cubic feet of gas per day through a 22/64-inch choke with flowing tubing pressure 100 pounds. No formation water was reported.

Production is from pay in Smackover through perforations 11,140-166 feet. Total depth is 11,284 feet and 5 1/2-inch casing was run to bottom for completion.

Rapad Drilling Co., Jackson, Miss., handled contract.

One-half mile west of the latest completion, Sklar earlier drilled No. 1 Craft-Brye 8-4, NW NW Section 8-4N-13E. A Smackover producer, the well flowed 130 barrels 43-gravity oil and 210,000 cubic feet of gas per day through a 20/64-inch choke with flowing tubing pressure 145 pounds.

Completion was from overall perforations in Smackover between 11,133 and 11,207 feet. Total depth is 11,515 feet and 5 1/2-inch casing was run to bottom.

Also in the Little Cedar Creek Field area, Sklar is waiting on tests at three other wells.

The No. 1 Craft-Ralls 4-5, SW NW Section 4-4N-13E, was drilled to 11,140 feet and cased to total depth.

The company's No. 1 Craft-Ralls 5-8, SE NE Section 5-4N-13E, was drilled to 11,150 feet and has casing to bottom.

Also awaiting completion is the No. 1 Craft-Ralls 5-10, NW SE Section 5-4N-13E. Bottomed at 11,200 feet, casing was run to total depth and perforations reported at 11,044-076 feet. This well is waiting on potential following acid treatment.
