

Sklar Logs Pay In Smackover At Conecuh County Wildcat

A significant development for the Little Cedar Creek Field area is indicated for southern Alabama's Conecuh County.

Sklar Exploration Co., LLC, Shreveport, La., is reported to have logged good pay in Smackover and run production casing at a wildcat one mile northeast of production at Little Cedar Creek Field.

The No. 7-2 Craft-Mack, NW NE Section 7-4N-13E, was drilled to 11,300 feet. Undisclosed shows were logged and string of 5 1/2-inch casing was run to 11,300 feet for completion.

Location of the current well is six and one-half miles northeast of the discovery well for Little Cedar Creek Field. Drill-site is three miles west-northwest of Paul.

Rapad Drilling Co., Jackson, Miss., handled contract.

About one mile east and slightly south of the current wildcat, Sklar last year drilled No. 1 Craft-Mack 8-7, SW NE Section 8-4N-13E. It was bottomed at 11,270 feet and abandoned in May with no details available.

One mile southwest of the current Sklar wildcat, Midroc Operating Co. completed No. 12-16 McCreary, SE SE Section 12-4N-12E. The well, on northeast flank of Little Cedar Creek Field, was completed flowing 71 barrels oil and 79,000 cubic feet of gas per day through a 14/64-inch choke with flowing tubing pressure 80 pounds.

Completion was from pay in Smackover through perforations 11,262-292 feet. Total depth is 11,530 feet and 5 1/2-inch casing was run to bottom for completion.
