

Sklar Logs Smackover Pay In Extension Area In Conecuh

Sklar Exploration Co., LLC, Shreveport, La., has run production casing at a wildcat in a southerly extension area to Little Cedar Creek Field in southern Alabama's Conecuh County.

Smackover pay was logged in the company's No. 1 Boothe & Casey 29-6, SE NW Section 29-4N-13E.

Hole was drilled to a depth of 11,750 feet. Shows were logged in Smackover and string of 5 1/2-inch casing was run to total depth for evaluation.

The well is located on a 169-acre drilling unit which includes the northwest quarter of Section 29.

A southeast offset to the indicated producer, Sklar earlier drilled the No. 1 Thomasson 29-10, NW SE Section 29-4N-13E.

Productive from pay in Smackover, the well pumped 525 barrels 48-gravity oil and 520,000 cubic feet of gas per day. No formation water was reported.

Production is from pay in Smackover from perforations 11,475-488 feet.

Hole was drilled to 11,768 feet. Shows were logged in Smackover and string of 5 1/2-inch casing was run to 11,715 feet for completion.
