

Offset To Producer Planned By Sklar In Conecuh County

Sklar Exploration Co., LLC, Shreveport, La., has sidetracked a Smackover test offsetting a Smackover producer in southern Alabama's Conecuh County.

The No. 1 Craft-Ralls 34-4 was drilled to a depth of 10,980 feet and logged. No commercial shows were reported and hole was plugged back for sidetrack. Hole was originally drilled from a surface location in NE NE Section 33-5N-13E, to a proposed bottom hole under NW NW Section 3-5N-13E.

The latest sidetrack will bottom the hole under the SE NW Section 34.

Rapad Drilling & Well Service, Inc., Jackson, Miss., is handling contract.

On the west offsetting 160-acre drilling unit, Sklar earlier completed the No. 1 Craft-Ralls 33-7, WW NE Section 33-5N-13E. The well pumped 147 barrels 43-gravity oil and 142 barrels water per day. Production is from pay in Smackover from perforations 10,838-854 feet following acid treatment.

Total depth is 10,880 feet and 5 1/2-inch casing was run to bottom for completion.

The current well is located on a 160-acre drilling unit which includes the northwest quarter of Section 34 while the earlier Unit 33-7 was drilled on a 160-acre unit which includes the northeast quarter of Section 33.
