

Smackover Wildcat Scheduled By Sklar In Conecuh County

Sklar Exploration Co., LLC, Shreveport, La., has scheduled a Smackover wildcat one and three-quarter miles west and slightly north of Melrose in southern Alabama's Conecuh County.

Drilling is planned for the No. 1 Craft-Ralls 33-6, SE NW Section 33-5N-13E. Drill-site is one-half mile north of production at Little Cedar Creek Field.

Location is on a 160-acre unit which includes the northwest quarter of Section 33.

One-quarter mile east of the new location, Sklar is currently testing the No. 1 Craft-Ralls 33-7, SW NE Section 33-5N-13E. Perforations in Smackover at 10,938-954 feet have been acidized and tests are underway with no results available.

Hole was drilled to 10,880 feet. Shows were logged in Smackover and 5 1/2-inch casing was run to 10,880 feet for completion.

One-half mile south of the latest location, Sklar earlier completed the No. 1 Craft-Ralls 33-14, SE SW Section 33-5N-13E.

A Smackover completion, the well flowed 395 barrels 40-gravity oil and 382,000 cubic feet of gas per day through a 18/64-inch choke with flowing tubing pressure 440 pounds.

Production is from pay in Smackover from perforations 10,928-956 feet.

Total depth is 11,100 feet and 5 1/2-inch casing was run to bottom for completion.
