

# Sklar Waiting On Rig To Test Smackover Well In Conecuh

Sklar Exploration Co., LLC, Shreveport, La., is waiting on completion rig to evaluate a Smackover test in a southerly extension area to Little Cedar Creek Field in southern Alabama's Conecuh County.

The No. 1 Boothe & Casey 29-6, SE NW Section 29-4N-13E, was drilled to a depth of 11,725 feet. String of 5 1/2-inch casing was run to total depth for evaluation of Smackover shows.

Location is on a drilling unit of 160 acres which includes the northwest quarter of Section 29.

At southeast diagonal offset the indicated producer, Sklar earlier drilled the No. 1 Thomasson 29-10, NW SE Section 29-4N-13E.

Productive from pay in Smackover, the well pumped 525 barrels 48-gravity oil and 520,000 cubic feet of gas per day on adjustable choke. No formation water was reported.

Production is from perforations 11,475-488 feet opposite pay in Smackover.

Hole was drilled to 11,768 feet. Shows were logged in Smackover and 5 1/2-inch casing was run to 11,715 feet for completion.
