

Sklar Completes Well On Northeast Flank Of Little Cedar Ck.

Sklar Exploration Co., LLC, Shreveport, La., has completed on pump at a Smackover well on northeast flank of Little Cedar Creek Field in southern Alabama's Conecuh County.

The No. 1-A Craft-Ralls 4-2, NW NE Section 4-4N-13E, was completed pumping 42 barrels oil per day. No formation water was reported.

Production is from pay in Smackover from perforations 10,923-932 feet.

Hole is bottomed at 11,155 feet in sidetrack. String of 5 1/2-inch casing was run to bottom for evaluation of shows logged in Smackover.

Slightly over one-half mile west-southwest of the latest completion, Sklar earlier completed No. 1 Craft-Ralls 4-5, SW NW Section 4-4N-13E. A Smackover completion, the well flowed 453 barrels 47-gravity oil, 492,000 cubic feet of gas and 12 barrels water per day through a 22/64-inch choke with flowing tubing pressure 150 pounds.

Completion was from pay in Smackover through perforations 10,962-988 feet. Total depth is 11,140 feet and 5 1/2-inch casing was run to 11,140 feet for completion.
