

Sklar Completes Well On Northeast Flank Of Little Cedar Ck.

Sklar Exploration Co., LLC, Shreveport, La., has completed in Smackover at a well on northeast flank of Little Cedar Creek Field in southern Alabama's Conecuh County.

Flowing 460 barrels 47-gravity oil and 428,000 cubic feet of gas per day, the company completed No. 1 Craft-Ralls 5-10, NW SE Section 5-4N-13E. Gauge was through an 18/64-inch choke with flowing tubing pressure 400 pounds. Gas-Oil ratio was 930 to one.

Completion was from pay in Smackover from a 32-foot interval of perforations between 11,044 and 11,076 feet.

Total depth is 11,200 feet. String of 5 1/2-inch casing was run to total depth to evaluate shows logged in Smackover.

Location is on a 160-acre unit which includes the southeast quarter of Section 5.

Rapad Drilling & Well Service, Inc., Jackson, Miss., handled contract.

At northeast offset to the latest completion, Sklar has drilled to 11,150 feet and run 5 1/2-inch casing to total depth at No. 1 Craft-Ralls 5-8, SE NE Section 5-4N-13E. Operator is waiting on completion rig to test.

At east offset to the No. 1 Craft-Ralls 5-8, Sklar has drilled to 11,140 feet at No. 1 Craft-Ralls 4-5, SW NW Section 4-4N-13E. Unreported shows were logged in Smackover and 5 1/2-inch casing was run to 11,140 feet for evaluation.

About 3000 feet northwest of the No. 1 Craft-Ralls 5-10, Sklar earlier completed No. 1 Craft-Cedar Creek Land & Timber 5-5, SW NW Section 5-4N-13E.

Productive from perforations 10,960-970 feet in Smackover, the well pumped 95 barrels 40-gravity oil per day.
