

Sklar Testing Smackover Wildcat Near Brooklyn In Conecuh County

Sklar Exploration, LLC, Shreveport, La., has perforated and is testing a Smackover wildcat two miles west and slightly north of Brooklyn in southern Alabama's Conecuh County.

The No. 1 Hamiter 32-3, NE NW Section 32-4N-13E, was perforated opposite pay in Smackover at 11,665-682 and 11,688-702 feet. Testing is currently underway with no results yet available.

Sklar drilled the No. 1 Hamiter 32-3 to a depth of 12,000 feet. Shows were logged in Smackover and string of 5 1/2-inch casing was run to 11,996 feet for completion.

Drill-site is two miles south of Little Cedar Creek Field and one and seven-eighths miles east of a recently completed discovery by Fletcher Petroleum Co.

Rapad Drilling & Well Service, Inc., Jackson, Miss., handled contract for drilling.

One and seven-eighths miles west of the indicated producer, Fletcher Petroleum recently completed the No. 36-3 Amos, NE NW Section 26-4N-12E.

A Smackover completion, the well flowed 531 barrels 48-gravity oil and 371,000 cubic feet of gas per day on an 18/64-inch choke with flowing tubing pressure 950 pounds. Gas-oil ratio was 704 to one.

Production is from pay in Smackover from perforations in a 28-foot section at 11,678-706 feet. Total depth is 11,968 feet and 5 1/2-inch casing was run to 11,924 feet for completion.
