

# Producer On Flank Of Little Cedar Ck. Flows 472 Bbl/Day

Sklar Exploration Co., LLC, Shreveport, La., has gauged good flow rate at a Smackover well on northeast flank of Little Cedar Creek Field in southern Alabama's Conecuh County.

The No. 1 Craft-Ralls 5-8, SE NE Section 5-4N-13E, flowed 472 barrels 47-gravity oil and 322,000 cubic feet of gas per day through a 20/64-inch choke with flowing tubing pressure 360 pounds.

Production is from a 24-foot section of perforations in Smackover at 11,005-030 feet. Total depth is 11,150 feet and 5 1/2-inch casing was run to bottom for completion.

Location is on a 160-acre unit which includes the northeast quarter of Section 5.

At offsetting unit to the south, Sklar recently completed No. 1 Craft-Ralls 5-10, NW SE Section 5-4N-13E.

Productive from Smackover, the well flowed 460 barrels 47-gravity oil and 428,000 cubic feet of gas per day through an 18/64-inch choke with flowing tubing pressure 400 pounds. Gas-oil ratio was 930 to one.

Completion was from perforations in Smackover between 11,044 and 11,076 feet.

Total depth is 11,200 feet. Shows were logged in Smackover and string of 5 1/2-inch casing was run to total depth for completion.

This well is on a 160-acre unit which includes the southeast quarter of Section 5.
