

Smackover Wildcat Scheduled By Sklar Near Little Cedar Ck.

Sklar Exploration Co., LLC, Shreveport, La., has scheduled a Smackover wildcat about one mile northeast of Little Cedar Creek Field in southern Alabama's Conecuh County.

Site was surveyed for No. 1 Cedar Creek Land & Timber 33-16, SE SE Section 33-5N-13E. Contractor for the proposed 11,600-foot wildcat is not available.

Location is on a 160-acre unit which includes the southeast quarter of Section 33. Drill-site is one mile west of Melrose.

Seven-eighths of a mile southwest of the new location, Sklar has run production casing at No. 1 Craft-Ralls 4-5, SW NW Section 4-4N-13E.

Hole was drilled to 11,140 feet. Shows were logged in Smackover and string of 5 1/2-inch casing was run to total depth for completion. No tests have yet been conducted.

One mile southwest of the latest location, Sklar has completed No. 1 Craft-Ralls 5-8, SE NE Section 5-4N-13E. A Smackover completion, the well flowed 472 barrels 47-gravity oil and 322,000 cubic feet of gas per day through a 20/64-inch choke with flowing tubing pressure 360 pounds.

Completion was from a 25-foot set of perforations in Smackover at 11,005-030 feet. Total depth is 11,150 feet and 5 1/2-inch casing was run to bottom for completion.
