

# Smackover Wildcat Is Staked By Sklar In Conecuh County

Sklar Exploration Co., LLC, Shreveport, La., has staked location for a Smackover wildcat one and five-eighths miles south of the main body of Little Cedar Creek Field in southern Alabama's Conecuh County.

The company will drill the No. 1 Cedar Creek Land & Timber, NW NE Section 33-4N-12E. The well is located on a 160-acre drilling unit which includes the northeast quarter of Section 33.

Contractor for the proposed 12,200-foot wildcat is not immediately known.

Location is three and one-quarter miles north-northeast of Fishpond. One and three-eighths miles north-northeast of the new location, Pruet Production Co. recently completed the No. 1 Cedar Creek Land & Timber 27-10, NW SE Section 27-4N-12E.

A Smackover producer, the well was completed flowing 392 barrels 48.5-gravity oil and 401,000 cubic feet of gas per day on a 14/64-inch choke with flowing tubing pressure 9950 pounds. Gas-oil ratio was 1023 to one. No formation water was reported.

Production is from pay in Smackover from perforations 10,800-826 feet.

Drilled to a depth of 12,000 feet, shows were logged in Smackover and string of 5 1/2-inch casing was run to total depth for completion.
