

Flank Conecuh County Well Flows At Rate 363 BOPD

Sklar Exploration Co., LLC, Shreveport, La., has completed in Smackover at a well in a southern extension area of Little Cedar Creek Field in southern Alabama's Conecuh County.

Production was established at the No. 1 Boothe & Casey 29-6, SE NW Section 29-4N-13E.

Productive from pay in Smackover, the well flowed 363 barrels oil per day on an 18/64-inch choke with flowing tubing pressure 360 pounds. Gas-oil ratio was 903 to one. No formation water was reported.

Hole was drilled to a depth of 11,750 feet. Shows were logged in Smackover and string of 5 1/2-inch casing was run to total depth for completion.

Perforations were reported earlier in Smackover at 11,594-603 and 11,622-629 feet.

Location is on a 160-acre drilling unit which includes the northwest

quarter of Section 29.

Rapad Drilling & Well Service, Inc., Jackson, Miss., handled contract.

At southeast offset to the new producer, Sklar earlier drilled the No. 1 Thomasson 29-10, NW NE Section 29-4N-13E.

Productive from pay in Smackover, the well was completed pumping 525 barrels oil and 520,000 cubic feet of gas per day. No formation water was reported.

Production is from perforations in Smackover from perforations 11,475-488 feet.

Hole was drilled to 11,868 feet. Shows were logged in Smackover and string of 5 1/2-inch casing was run to 11,715 feet for completion.
