

Sklar Completes In Smackover At Conecuh County Discovery

Sklar Exploration, LLC, Shreveport, La., has completed in Smackover at a wildcat two miles west and slightly north of Brooklyn in southern Alabama's Conecuh County.

Production was established at the No. 1 Hamiter 32-3, NE NW Section 32-4N-13E. The discovery flowed at rate of 540 barrels oil and 627,000 cubic feet of gas per day through a 12/64-inch choke with flowing tubing pressure 1850 pounds. Gas-oil ratio was 8621 to one. No formation water was present.

Production is from pay in Smackover from perforations 11,666-682 and 11,688-702 feet. Total depth is 12,000 feet. Shows were logged in Smackover and string of 5 1/2-inch casing was run to 11,996 feet for completion.

Drill-site is two miles south of Little Cedar Creek Field and one and seven-eighths miles east of a recent discovery completed by Fletcher Petroleum Co.

Rapad Drilling & Well Service, Inc., Jackson, Miss., handled contract.

One and seven-eighths miles west of the new production, Fletcher Petroleum recently completed the No. 3 Amos, NE NW Section 36-4N-12E.

A Smackover completion, the well flowed 531 barrels 48-gravity oil and 371,000 cubic feet of gas per day on an 18/64-inch choke with flowing tubing pressure 950 pounds. Gas-oil ratio was 704 to one.

Production is from pay in Smackover from perforations 11,678-700 feet.

Drilled to 11,968 feet, shows were logged in Smackover and string of 5 1/2-inch casing was run to 11,924 feet for completion.
