

Sklar Runs Production Pipe At Wildcat In Conecuh County

Sklar Exploration Co., LLC, Shreveport, La., has logged pay in Smackover and run production casing at a wildcat one and one-half miles south of the main body of Little Cedar Creek Field in southern Alabama's Conecuh County.

The No. 1 Cedar Creek Land & Timber 33-2, NW NE Section 33-4N-12E, was drilled to a depth of 12,000 feet. Shows were logged in Smackover and string of 5 1/2-inch casing was run to total depth for completion.

Location is on a drilling unit of 160 acres which includes the northeast quarter of Section 33-4N-12E.

Site of the wildcat is three and one-quarter miles north-northeast of Fishpond.

Rapad Drilling & Well Service, Inc., Jackson, Miss., handled contract for drilling.

One and three-eighths miles north-northeast of the indicated discovery, Pruet Production Co. com-

pleted the No. 1 Cedar Creek Land & Timber 27-10, NW SE Section 27-4N-12E.

A Smackover producer, the well was completed flowing 392 barrels 48.5-gravity oil and 401,000 cubic feet of gas per day on a 14/64-inch choke. No formation water was reported.

Production is from pay in Smackover from perforations 10,800-826 feet.

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
