

Tuscaloosa Wildcat Scheduled By Sklar In Wilkinson

Sklar Exploration Co., LLC, Shreveport, La., has scheduled a Lower Tuscaloosa wildcat for the area two and one-half miles southeast of Darrington in southwestern Mississippi's Wilkinson County.

The company received permit to drill the No. 1 Griffin & Griffin Exploration, LLC-U.S.A. 1-27, SW SE Section 27-4N-1W. Location is five-eighths of a mile south of Northwest Redbug Field which produces from Lower Tuscaloosa and one mile east of Crooked Creek Field which is productive of oil from Wilcox.

Contract has not been let for the 11,900-foot wildcat.

Five-eighths of a mile south of the new location, Ergen Resources Corp. completed the No. 1 U.S.A. 1-32, Section 32-4N-1W, discovery well for Northwest Redbug Field.

A Lower Tuscaloosa producer, the discovery flowed 1,500,000 cubic feet of gas and 336 barrels 45-gravity condensate per day through a 12/64-inch choke with flowing tubing pressure 2890 feet. Total depth is 11,798 feet and 5 1/2-inch casing was run to 11,756 feet.

Elevation was 280 feet, derrick floor. Top of Wilcox was logged at 5085 feet, Midway shale 8260, Upper Tuscaloosa 10,815, Marine Shale 11,075 and Lower Tuscaloosa "A" Sand 11,492 feet.
