

# Sklar Schedules Test In Extension Area Of Conecuh County

Sklar Exploration Co., LLC, Shreveport, La., has scheduled a Smackover test for flank of a southerly extension to Little Cedar Creek Field in southern Alabama's Conecuh County.

Site was surveyed for the No. 1 Cedar Creek Land & Timber 35-11. It will be drilled from a surface location in SE SW Section 35 to a proposed bottom hole under NE SW Section 35.

The well has a proposed measured depth of 12,293 feet and a true vertical depth of 12,103 feet.

Contractor for drilling is not presently available. Location of the well is on a 169-acre unit which includes the southwest quarter of Section 35.

An east offset to the new location, Sklar Exploration Co., LLC drilled the No. 1 Cedar Creek Land & Timber 35-10, NW SE Section 35-4N-12E.

A Smackover producer, the well flowed 277 barrels 48-gravity oil and 190,000 cubic feet of gas per day on a 21.64-inch choke with flowing tubing pressure 50 pounds. No formation water was reported.

Production is from perforations 11,799-820 feet.

Total depth is 12,080 feet. String of 5 1/2-inch casing was run to total depth for completion.

In the adjoining section to the west, Sklar will also drill a Smackover test. Scheduled for a depth of 12,500 feet is the No. 1 Graddy 34-8, SE NE Section 34-4N-12E. The 169-acre drilling unit includes the northeast quarter of Section 34. Contractor for drilling is not presently known.
