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# Smackover Wildcat Is Gauged By Sklar In Escambia County

Sklar Exploration Co., LLC, Shreveport, La., has established Smackover oil production at a wildcat in the extreme northeastern corner of southern Alabama's Escambia County.

Completion was reported for No. 1 Logan 5-7, SW NE Section 5-3N-13E. The discovery flowed 21 barrels 47-gravity oil and 57 barrels water per day through a 40/64-inch choke with flowing tubing pressure 8 pounds.

Completion was from perforations 11,820-832 feet in Smackover. Total depth is 12,225 feet and 5 1/2-inch casing was run to 12,225 feet for completion.

The new production is located three-quarters of a mile southwest of the community of Brooklyn and three and three-quarter miles south and slightly east of Smackover oil production at Little Cedar Creek Field in adjoining Conecuh County.

Three and three-quarter miles north and slightly west of the discovery, Midroc Operating Co. completed No. 24-1 McCreary, NE NE Section 24-3N-12E, on flank of Little Cedar Creek Field.

A Smackover completion, the well flowed 266 barrels 48-gravity oil and 143,000 cubic feet of gas per day through a 14/64-inch choke with flowing tubing pressure 350 pounds.

Completion was from pay in Smackover through perforations 11,580-610 feet. Total depth is 11,747 feet and 5 1/2-inch casing was run to bottom for completion.
