

Sklar Logs Pay In Smackover At Conecuh County Wildcat

Sklar Exploration Co., LLC, Shreveport, La., has logged pay in Smackover and run production casing at a wildcat two and three-quarter miles northwest of Paul in southern Alabama's Conecuh County.

The company's No. 1 Craft-Cedar Creek Land & Timber, Inc. 5-5, SW NW Section 5-4N-13E is bottomed at 11,200 feet. A core was cut in Smackover but details of recovery are not available. String of 5 1/2-inch casing was run to 11,193 feet.

Site of the wildcat is two miles northeast of the nearest completed well at Little Cedar Creek Field.

The indicated producer is located on a 160-acre unit which includes

the northwest quarter of Section 5-4N-13E.

Two wells have been drilled between the present well and the nearest completed producer at Little Cedar Creek Field. Both are awaiting completion.

Seven-eighths of a mile south-southwest of the No. 1 Craft-Cedar Creek 5-5, Sklar drilled No. 1 Craft-Mack 7-2, NW NE Section 7-4N-13E. It was bottomed at 11,300 feet and has casing to total depth.

Second of the wildcats is the Midroc Operating Co. No. 7-11 McCreary, NE SW Section 7-4N-13E. It is bottomed at 11,570 feet and has 5 1/2-inch casing to total depth. A completion rig has been moved on location.

Midroc drilled the nearest completed well on northeast flank of Little Cedar Creek Field at No. 12-16 McCreary, SE SE Section 12-4N-12E. The well flowed 71 barrels oil and 79,000 cubic feet of gas per day through a 14/64-inch choke with flowing tubing pressure 80 pounds.

Completion was from pay in Smackover through perforations 11,282-292 feet. Total depth is 11,530 feet and 5 1/2-inch casing was run to bottom for completion.
