

Production Pipe Run By Sklar On Flank Of Little Cedar Ck.

Sklar Exploration Co., LLC, Shreveport, La., has run production casing at a Smackover test on east flank of Little Cedar Creek Field in southern Alabama's Conecuh County.

The well, located one-half mile east of previous production, is No. 1 Craft-Brye 8-4, NW NW Section 8-4N-13E.

Hole was drilled to 11,515 feet. Shows were logged in Smackover "A" and Smackover "B" and string of 5 1/2-inch casing was run to 11,515 feet for evaluation.

Location of the well is on a 160-acre unit which includes the north-west quarter of Section 8.

Rapad Drilling Co., Jackson, Miss., handled contract.

One-half mile west of the current test, Sklar completed No. 1 Craft-Mack 7-2, NW NE Section 7-4N-13E. The well, a five-eighths of a mile north-northwest extension to the field, was completed flowing 73 barrels 43.3-gravity oil and 63,000 cubic feet of gas per day through a 14/64-inch choke with flowing tubing pressure 200 pounds.

Completion was from pay in Smackover through perforations 11,070-102 feet. Total depth is 11,300 feet and 5 1/2-inch casing was run to bottom.
