

Test Small Pumper Offsetting Extension To Little Cedar Ck.

Sklar Exploration Co., LLC, Shreveport, La., has completed a small pumping oil well offsetting a southerly extension to Little Cedar Creek Field in southern Alabama's Conecuh County.

The No. 1 Ralls 30-8, SE NE Section 30-4N-13E was completed pumping 12 barrels oil. No formation water was reported.

Production is from pay in Smackover from perforations 11,544-552 feet.

Sklar drilled the well to a depth of 11,780 feet. String of 5 1/2-inch casing was run to 11,780 feet for evaluation from shows logged in Smackover.

Rapad Drilling & Well Service, Inc., Jackson, Miss., handled contract.

The well was drilled on a 169-acre unit which includes the north-east quarter of Section 30.

At southeast diagonal offset to the latest completion, Midroc Operating Co. completed the No. 3 Mary Mack, SW SE Section 29-4N-13E.

A Smackover completion, the well flowed 420 barrels 48-gravity oil and 42,000 cubic feet of gas per day on a 10/64-inch choke with flowing tubing pressure 900 pounds. Gas-oil ratio was 1016 to one.

Drilled to a depth of 12,800 feet, string of 5 1/2-inch casing was run to total depth for completion.
