Sklar Tests Smackover Test In Conecuh Near Little Cedar Creek

Sklar Exploration Co., LLC, Shreveport, La., has tested a wildcat one and one-half miles south of the main body of Little Cedar Creek Field in southern Alabama's Conecuh County.

Results of tests will be released at a later date for the No. 1 Cedar Creek Land & Timber 33-2, NW NE Section 33-4N-12E. Production is from pay in Smackover from perforations 11,959-12,046 feet. Total depth is 12,200 feet and 5 1/2-inch production casing was run to total depth for completion.

Location is on a 160-acre unit which includes the northeast quarter of Section 33-4N-12E.

Site of the wildcat is three and one-quarter miles northeast of Fishpond.

Rapad Drilling & Well Service, Inc., Jackson, Miss., handled contract.

One and three-quarters miles north-northeast of the new well, Pruet Production Co. completed the No. 1 Cedar Creek Land & Timber 27-10, NW SE Section 27-4N-12E.

A Smackover producer, the well was completed flowing 392 barrels 48.5-gravity oil and 401,000 cubic feet of gas per day on a 14/64-inch choke. No formation water was reported.

Production is from pay in Smackover from perforations 10,800-820 feet.

Drilled to a depth of 12,000 feet, shows were logged in Smackover and string of 5 1/2-inch casing was run to total depth for completion.
