

Sklar Spuds Wildcat North Of Melrose In Conecuh County

Sklar Exploration Co., LLC, Shreveport, La., has spudded and is drilling below 3434 feet at a Smackover wildcat two miles north of Melrose in southern Alabama's Conecuh County.

The test, scheduled for a depth of 10,977 feet, is the No. 1 Craft-Soterra 27-2. It is being drilled from a surface location in NE NW Section 27 to a proposed bottom hole under NW NE Section 22-5N-13E.

Drill-site is one and one-eighth miles southwest of a recently completed Smackover discovery.

The well has a proposed measured depth of 10,977 feet and a true vertical depth of 10,700 feet.

The well is being drilled on a 160-acre unit which includes the southeast quarter of Section 27-5N-13E.

One and one-eighth mile northeast of the new location, Midroc Operating Co. drilled No. 23-3 Cedar Creek Land & Timber, NE NW Section 23-5N-14E.

Productive from Smackover, the discovery flowed from perforations 10,242-270 feet at rate of 468 barrels 48-gravity oil, 418,000 cubic feet of gas and two barrels water per day through a 12/64-inch choke with flowing tubing pressure 1400 pounds.

Drilled to 10,600 feet, casing was run to 10,579 feet for completion.
