

Sklar Schedules Test On Eastern Flank Of Little Cedar Creek

Sklar Exploration Co., LLC, Shreveport, La., has scheduled another Smackover test on east flank of Little Cedar Creek Field in southern Alabama's Conecuh County.

The company will directionally drill No. 1 Craft-Ralls 5-14. It will be drilled from a surface location in NW SW Section 5 to a proposed bottom hole under SE SW Section 5-4N-13E. Proposed depth is 11,600 feet with contractor not presently known.

Location is on a 160-acre unit which includes the southwest quarter of Section 5.

At south offset to the latest location, Sklar drilled to 11,515 feet and ran 5 1/2-inch casing to total depth at No. 1 Craft-Brye 8-4, NW NW Section 8-4N-13E. Operator is waiting on completion rig to test.

At north offset to the new location, Sklar is testing perforations 10,960-970 feet at No. 1 Craft-Cedar Creek Land & Timber, Inc. 5-5, SW NE Section 5-4N-13E. No test results are available.

Elevation was 394 feet, Kelly bushing. Top of Eutaw was logged at 3526 feet, Lower Tuscaloosa 4486, Haynesville 10,666, Crook sand 10,988, Frisco City sand 11,210, Smackover equivalent 11,346 and Basement 11,784 feet.
