

Perforate Smackover At Well On Flank Of Little Cedar Creek

Sklar Exploration Co., LLC, Shreveport, La., has perforated and is testing a Smackover well on east flank of Little Cedar Creek Field in southern Alabama's Conecuh County.

Perforations were reported in a 20-foot section at 11,187-207 feet at the company's No. 1 Craft-Brye 8-4, NW NW Section 8-4N-13E. The zone has been acidized.

Total depth is 11,515 feet. Shows were logged in both the Smackover "A" and the Smackover "B" zones and string of 5 1/2-inch casing was run to 11,515 feet for evaluation.

The well is located on a 160-acre unit which includes the northwest quarter of Section 8.

Rapad Drilling Co., Jackson, Miss., handled contract.

One-half mile west of the current test, Sklar completed No. 1 Craft-Mack 7-2, NW NE Section 7-4N-12E. The well was completed flowing 73 barrels 43.3-gravity oil and 63,000 cubic feet of gas per day through a 14/64-inch choke with flowing tubing pressure 200 pounds.

Completion was from pay in Smackover through perforations 11,070-102 feet. Total depth is 11,300 feet and 5 1/2-inch casing was run to bottom.
