

Sklar Tests Wildcat In Northwest Smith

Sklar Exploration Co., LLC, Shreveport, La., has tested Cotton Valley zones at a wildcat two and one-half miles northwest of Trenton in northwestern Smith County, Miss.

Wildcat is the company's No. 1 South Morton Unit 12, 2460 feet from south line and 2655 feet from west line Section 12-4N-6E.

The most recent perforations were reported at 13,960-973 feet. While the zone was indicated as gas productive, no gauge was filed with the State Oil & Gas Board.

Earlier perforations in the well were reported at 15,004-020, 14,940-958, 14,862-868, 14,925-932, 14,918-922, 14,646-666 and 14,694-700 feet.

Overall perforations between 14,648 and 14,948 feet were fractured before hole was plugged back to 14,600 feet.

Elevation is 403 feet, kelly bushing. Base Chalk was logged at 5904 feet, Lower Tuscaloosa 7230, Mooringsport 9919 and Cotton Valley 12,865 feet.

About 800 feet southwest of the current well, Phillips Petroleum Co. drilled No. D-1 Federal, NE SW Section 12-4N-6E. Hole was bottomed at 15,470 feet and abandoned in 1968. Scattered shows of oil were reported in sidewall samples but no test were reported.
