

# Extension Is Offset By Sklar Exploration In Conecuh County

Sklar Exploration Co., LLC, Shreveport, La., has offset a south extension to Little Cedar Creek Field in southern Alabama's Conecuh County.

Site was surveyed for the company's No. 1 Cedar Creek Land & Timber. A directional hole, it will be drilled from a surface location in NW SW Section 35 to a proposed bottom hole under SW NW Section 35-4N-12E.

The well will be drilled on a 160-acre unit which includes the northwest quarter of Section 35.

At west offset on 160-acre spacing, Sklar very recently completed the No. 1 Cedar Creek Land & Timber, SE NE Section 34-4N-12E. A Smackover completion, the well flowed at rate of 398 barrels 48.29-gravity oil and 350,000 cubic feet of gas per day on a 26/64-inch choke with flowing tubing pressure 175 pounds. Gas-oil ratio was 879 to one.

Production is from pay in Smackover from perforations 12,004-018 feet. Total depth is 12,220 feet. Pay was logged in Smackover and 5 1/2-inch casing was run to 12,220 feet for completion.

Elevation was 195 feet, kelly bushing. Top of Lower Tuscaloosa was logged at 5504 feet, Haynesville 13,356, Smackover 14,171 and Paleozoics 14,624 feet.
