

Sklar Tests Smackover Wildcat In Conecuh Flowing 398 BOPD

Sklar Exploration Co., LLC, Shreveport, La., has completed in Smackover at a wildcat in a southern extension area to Little Cedar Creek Field in southern Alabama's Conecuh County.

Production was established at the No. 1 Cedar Creek Land & Timber 34-9, SE NE Section 34-4N-12E. A Smackover completion, the well flowed at rate of 398 barrels 48.29-gravity oil, 350,000 cubic feet of gas per day on a 26/64-inch choke with flowing tubing pressure 175 pounds. No formation water was reported. Gas-oil ratio was 879 to one.

Production is from pay in Smackover from perforations 12,004-018 feet. Total depth is 12,220 feet. Shows were present in Smackover and string of 5 1/2-inch casing was run to 12,220 feet for completion.

Location of the discovery is on a 160-acre drilling unit which includes the northeast quarter of Section 34.

Rapad Drilling & Well Service, Inc., Jackson, Miss., handled contract.

Slightly over one mile west and slightly north of the current completion, Sklar completed the No. 1 Cedar Creek Land & Timber 33-2, NW NE Section 33-4N-12E.

The well was completed flowing 538 barrels 47.46-gravity oil and 540,000 cubic feet of gas per day on a 10/64-inch choke with flowing tubing pressure 101 pounds. No formation water was reported.

Production is from pay in Smackover from perforations 11,959-995 feet.
