

Sklar Tests Offset To Smackover Well In Conecuh County

Sklar Exploration Co., LLC, Shreveport, La., has completed in Smackover at an offset to a recent discovery south of Little Cedar Creek Field in southern Alabama's Conecuh County.

The No. 1 Mary Mack 31-2, NW NE Section 31-4N-13E, was completed pumping 245 barrels 48-gravity oil per day. No formation water was reported.

Production is from pay in Smackover from perforations 11,662-624 and 11,638-648 feet.

Drilled to a depth of 11,935 feet, shows were logged in Smackover and 5 1/2-inch casing was run to total depth for completion.

Location is on a 160-acre drilling unit which includes the northeast quarter of Section 31-4N-13E.

At northwest diagonal offset, Midroc Operating Co. recently completed the No. 30-14 Mary Mack, SE SW Section 30-4N-13E. The well flowed 561 barrels 48-gravity oil and 580,000 cubic feet of gas per day on a 10/64-inch choke with flowing tubing pressure 1700 pounds. No formation water was reported.

The well was originally perforated in Norphlet at 11,770-790 feet and flowed at rate of 159 barrels 56-gravity oil and 620,000 cubic feet of gas per day on a 10/64-inch choke with flowing tubing pressure 1700 pounds.

Drilled to a depth of 11,925 feet, shows were logged in both Smackover and Norphlet and casing was run to total depth for completion. Hole was plugged back and completed in Smackover.
