

Smackover Wildcat Completed By Sklar Flowing 348 BOPD

Sklar Exploration Co., LLC, Shreveport, La., has completed in Smackover at a wildcat two miles north of Melrose in southern Alabama's Conecuh County.

The No. 1 Craft-Soterra 27-2 was completed flowing 348 barrels 41-gravity oil and 376,000 cubic feet of gas per day through a 13/64-inch choke with flowing tubing pressure 480 pounds. Gas-oil ratio was 1081 to one. No formation water was reported.

Production is from pay in Smackover from perforations 10,866-891 feet. Total depth is 10,973 feet and 5 1/2-inch casing was run to bottom for completion.

The new producer was drilled from a surface location in NE NW Section 27 to a proposed bottom hole under NW NE Section 27-5N-13E.

Location is on a 160-acre unit which includes the northeast quarter of Section 27-5N-13E.

Rapad Drilling & Well Service, Inc., Jackson, Miss., handled contract for drilling.

About three-eighths of a mile southwest of the bottom hole of the latest completion, Sklar recently completed No. 1 Craft-Soterra 27-6, SE NW Section 27-5N-13E. The well flowed 577 barrels 48-gravity oil and 312,000 cubic feet of gas per day through a 22/64-inch choke with flowing tubing pressure 925 pounds. Gas-oil ratio was 541 to one.

Production is from perforations 10,597-616 and 10,619-626 feet in Smackover.

Drilled to 10,710 feet, shows were logged in Smackover and 5 1/2-inch casing was run to 10,710 feet for completion.
