

Sklar Drilling Flank Smackover Test For Little Cedar Creek

Sklar Exploration Co., LLC, Shreveport, La., has spudded and is drilling below 9076 feet at a Smackover test on east flank of Little Cedar Creek Field in southern Alabama's Conecuh County.

Current test is the No. 1 Craft-Mack 17-4, NW NW Section 17-4N-13E. Proposed depth is 11,600 feet.

Rapad Drilling & Well Service, Inc., Jackson, Miss., is handling contract.

One-half mile west of the current well, Midroc Operating Co. earlier completed No. 18-2 McCreary, NW NE Section 18-4N-13E. A Smackover completion, the well flowed 372 barrels 46-gravity oil and 346,000 cubic feet of gas per day through a 15/64-inch choke with flowing tubing pressure 540 pounds. Gas-oil ratio was 930 to one.

Completion was from a 36-foot section of perforations in Smackover at 11,250-286 feet.

Drilled to 11,550 feet, string of 5 1/2-inch casing was run to total depth for completion.
