

Wildcat In Escambia Scheduled By Sklar In Brooklyn Area

Sklar Exploration Co., LLC, Shreveport, La., has scheduled a Smackover test for the extreme northeastern corner of Escambia County in southern Alabama.

Moving about three-quarters of a mile southwest of the community of Brooklyn, location was staked for No. 1 Logan 5-7, SW NE Section 5-3N-13E. Drill-site is three and three-quarter miles south and slightly east of Smackover oil production at Little Cedar Creek Field.

Contractor for the proposed 12,600-foot wildcat is not known.

Drill-site is on a 160-acre unit which includes the northeast quarter of Section 5.

Three and three-quarter miles north and slightly west of the new location, Midroc completed No. 24-1 McCreary, NE NE Section 24-4N-12E, on flank of Little Cedar Creek Field.

A Smackover producer, the well flowed 266 barrels 48-gravity oil and 143,000 cubic feet of gas per day through a 14/64-inch choke with flowing tubing pressure 350 pounds.

Completion was from pay in Smackover through perforations 11,580-610 feet. Total depth is 11,747 feet and 5 1/2-inch casing was run to bottom for completion.
