

Sklar Begins Testing Smackover Wildcat In Conecuh County, Ala.

Sklar Exploration Co., LLC, Shreveport, La., has begun tests at a Smackover wildcat northeast of Little Cedar Creek Field in southern Alabama's Conecuh County.

Pay in Smackover is currently being evaluated at No. 1 Craft-Cedar Creek Land & Timber, Inc. 5-5, SW NW Section 5-4N-13E.

Drilled to a depth of 11,200 feet, shows were logged in Smackover and string of 5 1/2-inch casing was run to 11,193 feet for evaluation.

Perforations currently being evaluated are at 10,960-970 feet but no results of recovery are available.

Nabors Drilling USA, Houston, Texas, handled contract for drilling.

Seven-eighths of a mile southwest of this well, Sklar recently completed No. 1 Craft-Mack 7-2, NW NE Section 7-4N-13E. The well flowed 73 barrels 43-3-gravity oil per day through a 14/64-inch choke with flowing tubing pressure 200 pounds.

Completion was from pay in Smackover through perforations 11,070-102 feet. Total depth is 11,300 feet and 5 1/2-inch casing was run to bottom for completion. The producing zone was acidized prior to completion.

Completion of this well extended production at Little Cedar Creek Field five-eighths of a mile north-northeast of the nearest previous production in the field.
