

Sklar Completes Well In Conecuh County Pumping 525 BOPD

Sklar Exploration Co., LLC, Shreveport, La. has completed in Smackover at a well in a south extension area to Little Cedar Creek Field in southern Alabama's Conecuh County.

The company completed on pump at the No. 1 Thomasson 29-10, NW SE Section 29-4N-13E. The well pumped 525 barrels 48-gravity oil and 520,000 cubic feet of gas per day. No formation water was reported.

Production is from pay in Smackover from perforations 11,475-488 feet.

Drilled to a depth of 11,760 feet, shows were logged in Smackover and string of 5 1/2-inch casing was run to 11,715 feet for completion.

Energy Drilling Co., Natchez, Miss., handled contract.

The well is a northeast offset to the Sklar Exploration No. 1 Hamiter 32-3, NE NW Section 32-4N-13E.

A Smackover completion, the well flowed 540 barrels oil and 627,000 cubic feet of gas per day on a 12/64-inch choke with flowing tubing pressure 1850 pounds. No formation water was reported. Gas-oil ratio was 862 to one.

Production is from pay in Smackover from perforations 11,665-682 and 11,688-702 feet. Total depth is 12,000 feet and 5 1/2-inch casing was run to bottom for completion.
