

Production Pipe Run By Sklar In Conecuh In Melrose Area

Sklar Exploration Co., LLC, Shreveport, La., has run production casing at a Smackover wildcat one and one-half miles northwest of Melrose in southern Alabama's Conecuh County.

The No. 1 Craft Ralls 28-16, SE SE Section 28-5N-13E, was drilled to 10,940 feet. Undisclosed shows were logged in the well and string of 5 1/2-inch casing was run to 10,940 feet for evaluation.

A directional hole, both the surface and bottom hole locations are in the SE SE Section 28.

Location is on a 160-acre drilling unit which includes the southeast quarter of Section 28.

Rapad Drilling & Well Service, Inc., Jackson, Miss., handled contract.

One-half mile northwest of the indicated producer, Sklar has run production casing at No. 1 Craft-Smurfit-Stone 27-12, NW SW Section 27-5N-13E. It was bottomed at 10,811 feet and cased to 10,807 feet for evaluation of undisclosed shows.

Three-quarters of a mile northeast of the most recent indicated producer, Sklar completed the No. 1 Craft-Soterra 27-6, SE NE Section 27-5N-13E. The well was completed flowing 577 barrels 47-gravity oil and 312,000 cubic feet of gas per day through a 22/64-inch choke with flowing tubing pressure 925 pounds.

Completion was from Smackover from perforations 10,597-616 and 10,619-626 feet.
