Paleozoic test permitted by Fletcher Petroleum in Conecuh County, AL

Fletcher Petroleum Corp has added to the Paleozoic drilling program in Alabama's southern Conecuh County, along the southern flank of Little Cedar Creek field -- a rapidly expanding Smackover oil pool.

Plans call for the 1 Godwin "36" (API 01-035-20244) to be vertically drilled to a total depth of 12,500 ft. The new venture is located a mile north of the Escambia County line in the sw ne ne 36-4n-12e.

Nearly one-third of a mile to the northwest is Midroc Operating Co's 25-15 Kendall. The 11,945-ft vertical well was completed in February 2011 flowing 274 bbls of 48-degree oil and 322,000 cu ft of gas per day through Smackover perforations at 11,602-11,618 ft. During its first two months online, the wildcat yielded 3,504 bbls of crude, 3.84 million cu ft of gas and 488 bbls of water.

In 2010, Fletcher completed a Smackover well another half-mile to the southwest. Its 3 Amos "36" has produced 24,821 bbls of oil and 21.47 million cu ft of gas. Perforations are at 11,678-11,700 ft.

Sklar Exploration Co LLC has a couple of tests about a mile southwest of the proposed 1 Godwin. The 1 Cedar Creek Land & Timber "35-14" (API 01-035-20245), nw se sw 35-4n-12e, is slated to reach a total depth of 12,600 ft in the Paleozoic. Spudded on August 21, the 2 Cedar Creek Land & Timber (API 01-035-20243) is expected to reach a total depth of 12,828 ft, or a true vertical depth of 12,068 ft.

Two and three miles generally northeast of Fletcher's proposed test, Pruet Production Co is active at its 29-8 Boothe & Casey (API 01-035-20242) and the 4-13 Cedar Creek Land & Timber "21-10" (API 01-035-20241).
