

Sklar To Evaluate Smackover At Conecuh County Wildcat

Sklar Exploration Co., LLC, Shreveport, La., has run production casing at a Smackover wildcat one and one-quarter miles northwest of Melrose in southern Alabama's Conecuh County.

Potential producer is the No. 1 Craft-Ralls 33-8, SE NE Section 33-5N-13E. Hole was drilled to 11,205 feet. String of 5 1/2-inch casing was run to 11,203 feet for evaluation of undisclosed shows in Smackover.

Rapad Drilling & Well Service, Inc., Jackson, Miss., handled contract.

Site of the current well is three-quarters of a mile northeast of production at Little Cedar Creek Field.

Three-quarters of a mile southwest of the present test, Sklar earlier completed the No. 1 Craft-Ralls 33-14, SE SW Section 33-5N-13E.

Productive from Smackover, the well flowed 395 barrels 40-gravity oil and 382,000 cubic feet of gas per day through a 17/64-inch choke with flowing tubing pressure 440 pounds.

Gas-oil ratio was 967 to one.

Production is from pay in Smackover through perforations 10,926-956 feet. Total depth is 11,100 feet in second sidetrack and string of 5 1/2-inch casing was run to 11,100 feet for completion.
