Sklar To Test Smackover Well In Little Cedar Creek Area

Sklar Exploration Co., LLC, Shreveport, La., has run production casing at a Smackover wildcat in the Little Cedar Creek Field area of southern Alabama's Conecuh County.

The No. 1 Craft-Ralls 8-12, NW SW Section 8-4N-13E, was drilled to 11,280 feet. Undisclosed shows were logged in the well and string of 5 1/2-inch casing was run to 11,280 feet for completion.

Permitted as a wildcat, location is three-eighths of a mile east of production at Little Cedar Creek Field. Rapad Drilling Co., Jackson, Miss., handled contract for drilling.

Three-eighths of a mile west of the current test, Midroc Operating Co. completed No. 7-9 McCreary, NE SE Section 7-4N-13E. Productive from pay in upper Smackover, the well flowed 450 barrels 48-gravity oil and 405,000 cubic feet of gas per day through a 12/64-inch choke with flowing tubing pressure 840 pounds.

Completion was from perforations in upper Smackover at 11,115-119 feet. Total depth is 11,500 feet and 5 1/2-inch casing was run to bottom for completion.

The company had perforated earlier in Smackover at 11,150-190 feet. Tests were run following acid treatment but no results were released.
