

# **Sklar Tests Wildcat Pumping 95 BBL/Day In Conecuh County**

Sklar Exploration Co., LLC, Shreveport, La., has completed in Smackover at a wildcat in the Little Cedar Creek Field area of Conecuh County in southern Alabama.

The well, located about three-quarters of a mile north of the nearest production at Little Cedar Creek Field, is No. 1 Craft-Cedar Creek Land & Timber, Inc. 5-5, SW NW Section 5-4N-13E.

Productive from perforations 10,960-970 feet in Smackover, the well pumped 95 barrels 40-gravity oil per day.

When the well was logged in April of 2006, the location was about two miles northeast of the nearest production in the field.

Total depth is 11,200 feet and 5 1/2-inch casing was run to 11,193 feet.

Sklar completed the nearest presently producing well at Little Cedar Creek Field about three-quarters of a mile south of the latest completion.

Earlier completion was the No. 1 Craft-Brye 8-4, NW NW Section 8-4N-13E. A Smackover completion, the well flowed 130 barrels 43-gravity oil and 210,000 cubic feet of gas per day through a 20/64-inch choke with flowing tubing pressure 145 pounds.

Completion was from overall perforations in Smackover between 11,133 and 11,207 feet. Total depth is 11,515 feet and 5 1/2-inch casing was run to bottom.
