

# Sklar Tests Offset To Discovery Well In Conecuh County

Sklar Exploration Co., LLC, Shreveport, La., has tested the west offset to a Smackover discovery two and one-half miles west and slightly north of Brooklyn in southern Alabama's Conecuh County.

Tests were conducted at the No. 2 Cedar Creek Land & Timber 35-8, SE NE Section 35-4N-12W. Results will be released later on the tests conducted on the well. Production is from pay in Smackover from perforations 12,118-124 feet.

Rapad Drilling & Well Service, Inc., Jackson, Miss., handled contract.

At east offset to the latest completion, Fletcher Petroleum Co., Fairhope, Ala., completed the No. 36-3 Amos, NE NW Section 36-4N-12E.

A Smackover completion, the discovery flowed 531 barrels 48-gravity oil and 371,000 cubic feet of gas per day on an 18/64-inch choke with flowing tubing pressure 950 pounds. Gas-oil ratio was 704 to one.

Production is from pay in Smackover from perforations 11,678-700 feet. Total depth is 11,968 feet and 5 1/2-inch casing was run to 11,934 feet for completion.

The discovery is located one and one-half miles south of Smackover oil production at Little Cedar Creek Field.
