

Sklar Sidetracks Little Cedar Creek Test In Conecuh

Sklar Exploration Co., LLC, Shreveport, La., has sidetracked a Smackover test on east flank of Little Cedar Creek Field in southern Alabama's Conecuh County.

The company is drilling below 8239 feet in sidetrack at No. 1 Craft-Mack 8-15, SW SE Section 8-4N-13E.

Hole was drilled to 11,500 feet in original and decision was made to sidetrack.

The well is located on a 160-acre unit which includes the southeast quarter of Section 8.

Rapad Drilling & Well Service, Inc., Jackson, Miss., is handling contract.

About 3000 feet northwest of the current test, Sklar earlier completed No. 1 Craft-Ralls 8-12, NW SW Section 8-4N-13E.

A Smackover completion, the well flowed 444 barrels 43-gravity oil, 384,000 cubic feet of gas and one barrel water per day through an 18/64-inch choke with flowing tubing pressure 440 pounds.

Completion was from a 33-foot section of perforations in Smackover at 11,150-183 feet.

Hole was drilled to 11,280 feet and string of 5 1/2-inch casing was run to total depth.
