

Sklar Begins Testing Little Cedar Ck. Well

Sklar Exploration Co., LLC, Shreveport, La., has begun testing in Smackover at a well on eastern side of Little Cedar Creek Field in southern Alabama's Conecuh County.

The No. 1 Craft-Mack 17-4, NW NW Section 17-4N-13E, was perforated 11,186-206 and 11,224-228 feet. Tests are underway with no results yet available.

The well was drilled to 11,420 feet. String of 5 1/2-inch casing was run to test shows logged in Smackover.

Rapad Drilling & Well Service, Inc., Jackson, Miss., handled contract.

At west offset to the currently testing well, Midroc Operating Co. completed No. 18-2 McCreary, NW NE Section 18-4N-13E, The Smackover completion flowed 372 barrels 48-gravity oil and 346,000 cubic feet of gas per day through a 15/64-inch choke with flowing tubing pressure 540 pounds. Gas-oil ratio was 930 to one.

Completion was from perforations in Smackover at 11,250-285 feet. Total depth is 11,550 feet and 5 1/2-inch casing was run to bottom for completion.
