

# **Sklar Tests Offset To Discovery Well In Conecuh County**

Sklar Exploration Co., LLC, Shreveport, La., has completed an offset to an earlier Smackover discovery in southern Alabama's Conecuh County.

Production was established at the company's No. 2 Cedar Creek Land & Timber 35-8. The well was completed flowing 257 barrels oil and 97,000 cubic feet of gas per day on a 7/64-inch choke with flowing tubing pressure 1110 pounds. Gas-oil ratio was 377 to one. No formation water was reported.

Production is from perforations 12,118-124 feet from pay in Smackover. Total depth is 12,230 feet in sidetrack and 5 1/2-inch casing was run to 12,230 feet for completion.

Rapad Drilling & Well Service, Inc., Jackson, Miss., handled contract.

A directional hole, the well was drilled from a surface location in NW SE Section 36 to a proposed bottom hole under SE SE Section 35.4N-12E.

Location is on a 160-acre drilling unit which includes the northeast quarter of Section 35.

Location is about 3000 feet west-southwest of the Fletcher Petroleum Co. discovery and three-quarters of a mile south of Smackover oil production in Little Cedar Creek Field.

Fletcher recently completed the No. 3 Amos, NE NW Section 36-4N-12E.

A Smackover producer, the discovery well flowed 531 barrels 48-gravity oil and 371,000 cubic feet of gas per day on an 18/64-inch choke with flowing tubing pressure 950 pounds.

Production is from pay in Smackover from perforations 11,678-700 feet. Total depth is 11,968 feet and casing was run to 11,924 feet for completion.
