

Sklar Schedules Test East Of Production At Little Cedar Ck.

Sklar Exploration Co., LLC, Shreveport, La., has scheduled a Smackover test one-half mile east of Little Cedar Creek Field in southern Alabama's Conecuh County.

The test, permitted a wildcat, is the No. 1 Craft-Mack 8-2, NW NE Section 8-4N-13E.

Proposed depth is 11,600 feet to evaluate through Smackover with contractor not presently available.

The well is located on a 160-acre unit which includes the northeast quarter of Section 8.

Site of the test is two miles west-northwest of Paul.

One-half mile west of the new location, Sklar completed No. 1 Craft-Brye 8-4, NW NW Section 8-4N-13E. A Smackover completion, the well flowed 130 barrels 43-gravity oil and 210,000 cubic feet of gas per day through a 20/64-inch choke with flowing tubing pressure 145 pounds.

Completion was from overall perforations in Smackover between 11,133 and 11,207 feet. Total depth is 11,515 feet and 5 1/2-inch casing was run to bottom.
